*"In Velz the minhag was that when a chossid had a birthday that was Bo Beyom on Shabbes, a second Sefer Torah was taken out for maftir. The maftir would be read from the maftir at the end of Parshas Vayayshev, Vayehi bayom hashlishi Yom Huledes es Paroh. The Rebbe himself would read the maftir. When the Rebbe got to the last word "VAYISHKOCHAYHU," he would pause to allow the whole congregation to say that word out loud in unison and then the Rebbe would conclude, repeating with great hislahavus, VAYISHKOCHAYHU!" -Rabbi Mel Teitelbaum
