**Gut Shabbos**

*"During the month of Elul, when reciting the Psalm, Ledovid Hashem Ori, , the minhag in Velz was that, at the Shachris recitation, the congregation would begin by shouting out loud, in unison, the word L'dovid. The congregation then paused for the Rebbe to blow the shofar. After hearing the sound of the shofar the congregation continued with the next word— Hashem and the remainder of the Psalm. The Rebbe explained that the word Shofar is b'gematria 586 and added to the word Hashem, which is b'gematria 26, it totals 612. Therefore, the Rebbe pointed out, we blow the shofar right at this point as a reminder to do what we can during this month of Elul to dedicate ourselves to Hashem and to observing the remaining 612 mitzvos.*

*When attending a wedding during the month of Elul the Velzer Rebbe established the minhag that under the chupah, when reciting the brocho achritta (final brocho) the gathered guests would pause after singing the words kol sason, kol simcha, kol chosson, kol kallah ( yes in Velz the guests in attendance did so sing) and the Rebbe would sound the shofar to add the kol shofar to the celebration."-Rabbi Mel Teitelbaum*




We have refurbished our shul mikvah so that members of the community can use it in comfort regardless of ability to pay.
