"Already at his Melave Malkah on the Motzay Shabbes before Rosh Hashannah, the Veizer Rebbe would dip the Matzee in honey so that he could then distribute the shirayim therefrom on the first night of Rosh Hashannah. And, when greeting his chassidim on that first night of Rosh Hashannah, the Veizer Rebbe, who had taught himself to extend greetings of Kesiva Vachsim'a Tova in many languages, would greet each chossid with such a greeting in a different language. The Rebbe explained that in the "Unsaneh Takef" Mussaf prayer we say "V'chol Bo-ay Olam Yaavrun Lefonecha," therefore it was important to know how to greet people with the Rosh Hashannah greeting in all the world's languages. As the Chassidim would file past the Rebbe after davening on the first night of Rosh Hashanah the Rebbe would greet each chossid in a different language. The Rebbe would remember which language he used for each chossid. Then on the following night, to each chossid who remembered and repeated the greeting in the language in which the Rebbe had greeted him the previous night, the Rebbe would give a special additional individual packet of honey shirayim to be used for dipping the new fruit. This came to be called Sheheche-yoneh honey."-Rabbi Mel Teitelbaum
