Gut Shabbos

"In Velz the minhag was to celebrate around bonfires on Pesach Shaynee, not on Lag B'Omer. The Velzer Rebbe explained that for Pesach Shaynee we should perform a ceremony of burning like we do for the first Pesach. However, since Pesach Shaynee is always very close to Lag B'Omer (4 days), therefore in Miron they make the Pesach Shaynee bonfire on Lag B'Omer. After all, the Rebbe explained, Pesach Shaynee is for those who were far away. "B'derech Rechokah." The word Rechokah is gemtarya 313 and the word Miron is gematria 306. So if you add to the 306 of Miron the 4 days in between Pesach Shaynee and Lag B'Omer and the 3 years of the boys of haircut age, both "Rechokah" and "Miron" each total 313."-Rabbi Mel Teitelbaum
