## Gut Shabbos

*During the Three weeks the Velzer Rebbe would not utilize any underground transportation. The Velzer Rebbe noted that the Korach dispute lasted three weeks and is generally read right around the time of the three weeks. The Velzer Rebbe pointed out that Korach and his "aydah" were punished by being swallowed underground because their base of operations was underground as the posuk says "hay-olu misaviv l'mishkan Korach..." and later again "V'yay-olu mayal mishkan Korach...". Clearly, while underground, they were swallowed alive "chayyim" to the deeper depths of "sh'olah". The earth opened so that the b'nai yisrael should see what had happened underground. The Velzer Rebbe further explained that we know the Korach dispute lasted three weeks from the posuk "rav lachem b'nai layvee" and the words "b'nai layvee" are repeated three times. This tells us, said the Velzer Rebbe, that on three consecutive shabbasim, Moshe assured the B'nai layvee that he will be there to be their "Rav" and will not undertake speaking engagements. This satisfied the b'nai layvee's complaint that every other week Moshe had a speaking engagement as evidenced from the oft repeated posuk "vayedabayr H'shem el Moshe laymor."-Rabbi Mel Teitelbaum*
