GUEST SPEAKER: IN MEMORY OF RAV SHMUEL CHMELNICKI Z"L, THE TULNER REBBE FROM ASHDOD

"The Velzer Rebbe taught that the minhag for a chosson to circle around the kallah seven times under the chuppah has its origins with the Bnos Tzlofchod. It was deemed a special segulah for the kallah to raise her children in the respectful manner in which the Bnos Tzlofchod approached Moshe Rabbeinu with their inquiry. To perpetuate that segulah, the Chosson would recite the names of the five Bnos Tzlofchod as he was circling. For her part, as the chosson was circling, the Kallah would repeatedly recite the phrase from the possuk "Latov b'aynayhem tee'yanu l'nashim" (to one who is pleasing in their eyes they shall be wives) as a segulah that the chosson should continue to forever find favor in his wife's eyes. The Rebbe explained that he learned this from his stepfather who was an aynykel of the bnos Tzlofchod."-Rabbi Mel Teitelbaum
